  - a. Find the letter of the scale/key you are looking for.
  - b. Look above that letter to know the number of  $\#/\flat$  in that key.
  - c. Follow the order of sharps in the box (flats start with B and go in reverse order) to know which notes are sharp or flat in the scale.
  - d. You can start with the number of sharps or flats, go to that number on the correct side of the Magic Wand to locate the name of the Major scale/key.
